Do you mobilize and lead volunteers? Are you looking for a way to strengthen your professional credibility? If so, now is the time to consider earning the **CVA (Certified in Volunteer Administration)** credential, originally developed by the Association for Volunteer Administration and now sponsored by the Council for Certification in Volunteer Administration. CCVA offers this unique program to recognize practitioners in the field of volunteer resources management who meet specified standards as measured through an exam and a written portfolio. This is a self-study process requiring no travel or special classes.

Individuals with the equivalent of at least 3 years of experience leading and directing volunteers are eligible. The deadline for registering for the next cycle is **March 1, 2010**. Candidates registering for this cycle must take the Exam in May 2010 (via web-based testing software), and must complete the written Portfolio component by December 31, 2010.
